

A few words from John

Social Network – A structure made up of individuals connected by one or more interdependency such as common interest, friendship and knowledge.

I started off this message with a definition for a reason. The USKBTC Board along with the AKC has been working on ways to increase the interest in pure bred dogs and in that way increase the number of registered dogs. The AKC has come out with a new I-Phone application. Our membership is aware of the Grand Champion program, the Breeder of Merit and other programs put forth by the AKC which a number of members participate in. A number of our members have been recognized in all the categories. There are new competitions for our Kerries such as scent dog and dock jumping. Each new endeavor increases the potential for our membership to widen their relationship with other people who have similar interests. The word is passed about Kerries. I ask someone to be a friend on a social network product not because I own a Kerry, but because I am interested in Rally, Obedience, hypo-allergenic dogs, etc... The people who didn't know what a Kerry could do now see a video on a Facebook page about herding or see a message on the Linked In network about a dog called Ivan who is now our library card holding Kerry. This is all part of our communication about the breed and how to get our message out about how wonderful and exciting a Kerry can be. We need to post these positive stories and not let the negative overshadow the good. We have to get out our message about the great things we have done in rescue and the success stories of those placements. Many, many people approach Kathy and I about Kerries just because of some pictures that she posted or because of who we are friends with. These may or may not amount to future ownership, but the seeds are set about Kerries being fun, versatile and loving.

Many of the goals we are pursuing are intended to raise the visibility and stature of Kerry Blue Terriers, to make it the breed of choice for the very best dog owners and to ensure that those owners who own a Kerry have the highest quality experience. If we are successful, the results will include 1) increased recognition, more registrations and an improved bloodline, and 2) increased and broader Kerry ownership. Success here will be the first step in moving us closer to achieving the broader vision.

The USKBTC needs to put together a strategy for marketing and communication of the strengths of our breed. As you have often heard us say, we need to do more "to get our name out there". Various strategies such as bill-boards, license plate holders, paid print ads and Meet the Breed functions are examples of deliberate actions we have taken in this regard. There needs to be a strategy for increasing the number of registered Kerries. It should include in part some suggestions on what to do with stories like Ivan's. To accomplish this, the USKBTC needs volunteers. I am not an expert in marketing or communication. However, a number of our members may be. We need a committee to discuss and come up with tactical and long term suggestions for getting the word out about Kerries. Please help us set the direction for the next 5-10 years. Speak to a Board member or to me directly.

We are always looking for a few good volunteers. We are currently looking for members who are interested in judging Sweeps and the Futurity from 2012. We are looking for people interested in running our dinner and the raffles at the annual meeting. The USKBTC is made up of volunteers. We need more people who want "to do". Remember. To better our club – volunteer. To help rescue – volunteer. To improve our breed – volunteer. I don't always remember quotations, but an organization I belonged to at one time always used one when looking for volunteers. "I am only one, but I am one. I cannot do everything but I can do something. And I will not let what I cannot do interfere with what I can do." Edward Everett Hale.

Finally, February was Westminster month and the snow was melting so I went to Madison Square Garden. People were 4 deep around the Kerry ring. (They are small rings.) I started to talk to the people standing next to me and it turned out that her grandfather was a breeder and owner back in the 30's and 40's. She was going to make the jump into getting a dog and because of her remembrances of growing up with Kerries, a Kerry Blue was the breed for her. One week later she was the owner of a male Kerry from one of our members. Kerries have and will continue to touch our souls. Let's take that message to a new generation of people.



Spotlight on our Future... *McKenna Marie Vance



Many years ago, during a cold and rainy Montgomery weekend, a little girl barely 8 years old, wearing a white raincoat and hat, appeared on the scene with a Kerry pup. She stood out as the tiniest participant that week in a large ring full of dogs and power handlers--not at all fazed by the strength of her competition.

Much taller, but still quiet and very unassuming, McKenna Vance, still enjoys showing that

same Kerry--as a Veteran special and in Junior Handlingand she has been making quite a stir on the recent dog show scene. Once the #1 Kerry Junior Handler, her re-

cent Best Junior Handler win at the Florida Classic Cluster earned her a \$1,000 scholarship-her proudest win to date!



McKenna's parents grew

up showing dogs, so it was no surprise their kids would have an interest for the sport. McKenna's love for Kerries began eight years ago, while tagging along at a dog show with her older brother and his Wheaten Terrier. Not having a dog of her own, she was asked to 'babysit' a puppy for a few hours while the owners went to lunch. It's never been determined if that 'babysitting' was part of a greater plan, but thankfully, that Kerry pup later became her first dog, 'Aillee'. The family has since become good friends



with Walter and Barbara Bates, and they are usually front and center at the junior ring!

Once 'Aillee' finished, McKenna had expressed a desire to continue on with

her passion for showing and become more entrenched

with the sport by adding a new dog to her lineup. After thoughtful planning, Symphonie's Fleur de Lys, 'Sophie', was brought home to love and grow, and she will be McKenna's new focus.

The family has a 'no dog left behind' policy....they incorporate their dogs with every part of daily living, and therefore, have a limited number of dogs-currently only the two! The Vance kids are very involved with activities and the dogs are willing



participants--'Aillee' was the team mascot for McKenna's school softball team and has also traveled to football



games to accompany her cheer-leading squad.
McKenna's youngest brother Harrison adopted 'Sophie' as their team mascot, but as a small pup, all she really cared about was playing in the shrubbery! 'Sophie' has a morning chicken

biscuit routine-and it's quite comical how the dogs have become well known at local drive thru restaurants!

With her show wins advertised in the local newspaper, some have approached her with a need for dog



training. McKenna has reached out to the public and offered assistance, and she also has created 'The Groom Room' which is her home-based shop where she grooms neighbors, teachers and friend's dogs at a minimal charge to cover her expenses. McKenna believes having a well-

behaved, clean pet is more likely to be loved and cared for.

With every show, McKenna has done more and more of her own grooming on her Kerries. As you all know, many of the shows are won and lost on the grooming table,





and it's no easy task to properly prepare them for the ring. She is becoming more confident with her scissoring and has shown great progress. She hopes to gain even more insight this summer when she visits her breeder/friend France Godbout in Canada

and can spend some time learning and improving her grooming and handling techniques-- and of course, hopes to enjoy showing the dogs!

In school, McKenna suggested her class take on a special project to assist the local Sheriff department with their canine unit, as it was brought to her attention that they had a need for 'pop locks'. This item would allow the officer to release his canine from the car to assist him from a remote control. These locks are very expensive, so she began a "Kids for K-9 Kops" fund



raiser and helped raise money for this cause. She is shown here be honored with one of the retiring K-9's and his officer.



McKenna assisted the Kerry Blue Terrier Club of Central Florida in September at the AKC's Responsible Dog Owner Day in Tampa. Although the one-way drive was over seven

hours long, she felt it was important to help the club by discussing the advantages/disadvantages of owning a Kerry and educating the public on the importance of proper training.

This past August, McKenna traveled to the University of Georgia and participated in the AKC's Breeder Symposium. It



was important for her to hear from experts and be better informed of health concerns facing the breed, and to learn of measures that promote good health if she is to breed a litter of Kerries in the future. Being on this campus, honed her desire to pursue Veterinary medicine, as she had been volunteering her time after

school every week at both local veterinary clinics to gain additional insight on this career path.

She is also a mentor to several junior handlers interested in learning more about dogs, including her little brother, Harrison. For him, she has made a very generous gift-her trained Juniors dog. Starting out, she felt it important that he have a dog that can be a good teammate, but this puts her at a disadvantage with an inexperi-



enced dog as her teammate. "All the more a challenge!" she giggles. McKenna also has assisted with the first annual Kerry Blue Terrier Club of Central Florida's Junior Handling Clinic held in conjunction with

the Terrier Specialty. Seven juniors participated--and none had shown before--so this was a wonderful opportunity to introduce kids & Kerries to juniors and she felt it was important to support and encourage each other in the sport.

McKenna had qualified for the AKC Eukanuba Classic Invitational in Long Beach, CA but was unable to attend due to the death of her grandfather. Her goal for 2011 is to again, qualify for the show and the prestigious Westminster show in New York City. She is hard at work and saving her earnings!



When asked, McKenna will tell you that training dogs has taught her many life lessons. "Caring for another living soul is a huge responsibility. The work involved with

training and keeping a show dog conditioned takes many hours—for a brief moment in the show ring! Having a good work ethic and giving up certain usual youth activities to prepare for shows, is a must if you are to be any good in the ring. Sometimes adults don't always recognize what is sacrificed by a junior—just to compete." If asked, she will tell you she has learned far more from losing than winning. "Good sportsmanship, perseverance

and a 'never give up' attitude developed after many RE-

SERVE placements. My Kerry turned blue very late and it took nearly 6 years for her to finish. Most people would have given up by then or moved on to another dog. But I didn't have another dog, and given time, I knew someday she would be a champion



on paper, as she was always a champion in my heart.

McKenna would like to convey one thought....if you have a kid-friendly 'retired' show dog that loves and misses the show scene, contact a junior handler in your area and offer them the opportunity to show a great dog. Keeping kids and Kerries in the ring will ensure the longevity of the sport!

In closing, I think you will likely see McKenna at shows for many years to come as she truly has found something she LOVES! She has made her family, school and community proud, and hopefully when you meet her, you will support her efforts in and out of the ring!



IVAN. . . And the Paws to Read Program June Hulit

He's a ham! He loves people.....especially kids! He's loyal! He is soft to touch! He has energy....yet he is laid back for his breed! He is fun! He has a beard! He likes other dogs! He is unique! He is a love! He is a therapy dog! He is a Kerry Blue Terrier!

That's our boy......Ivan the Terrific! Yes....that is what he is named. We certainly did not want him to be confused with that "other" Ivan that was so popular in history. From 10 a.m. to 12 noon on Saturdays, we attend the local "Paws to Read" program at our relatively new Wayne County Library in downtown Wooster, Ohio.

The therapy dogs and their handlers belong to a local social group called CTC or Caring Therapy Canines. This very active group of folks/volunteers have "registered" therapy dogs being members of either Therapy Dogs Incorporated (Wyoming) or Delta Society. Most of these dogs have been adopted from the local pound or a breed rescue organization, including Ivan.

The handlers with their dogs volunteer to read to kids (if the kids are unable to read) or if the children can read, the handlers may ask the kids to choose a book from the bookshelves of the library to read to one of the therapy dogs. The kids position themselves on the floor beside the therapy dog and begin reading. The handler helps the reader......if needed..........if needed..........and after the child has finished reading to the dog, the handler remarks to the child, "Good job!"

It is a program entitled "The Paws to Read" program. In other cities or other states, it might be given some other title; BUT the point is, children feel more at ease reading to a "dog" rather than to a large group of their peers as in a classroom setting. The kids sit and stroke the dogs as they read......allowing the child to feel more relaxed. The "dog" does not threaten them nor pass judgment as to the individual child's reading skills.

And if they do not choose to read......no problem.....they might come up and approach the dog and pet one of the therapy dogs. If the child starts to reach to pet Ivan on the head......Ivan backs up. The child has not "introduced" himself in a proper manner. The handler instructs the child (and sometimes the adult) to let the dog "sniff" their hand. This is the way to "introduce" ones self to a dog....just like an adult shaking the hand of another human. It is a form of greeting another....but with the dog......the dog knows......the individual may have other pets or a little bit of leftover maple syrup they had on their pancakes at McDonalds because of their sense of smell. After the proper greeting has been established, the therapy dog proceeds to greet the child and allows the child to pet, stroke them, etc.

Questions occur......especially to Ivan the Terrific, they ask, "How does he see?" "With two eyes, I answer." Then there is a giggle. Then I explain the purpose of the fall or beard of the KBT. They were bred by the Irish commoner to be a family companion, a family protectorate, go to ground for vermin, herd the cattle or sheep and to help the Irishman with his pants in the morning and to help him home from the pub in the evening." The parent overseeing their children laughs; the kids give a smile and continue to pet Ivan.

Ivan knows no stranger. He has a job. He eagerly enters the library on Saturday with his head held high and his tail set the same. 



Preheat oven to 350° F. Mix all ingredients. Knead for 3 minutes (dough should form a ball). Roll on floured surface to ½ inch thick, then cut into dog bone shapes with a cookie cutter. Bake on lightly greased cookie sheet for 20 minutes.

REGISTER OF MERIT POLICY

 Members of the USKBTC, as S at all times. A member's every action sho 			nd serve the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier bove all, the Kerry Blue Terrier.

I. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A MEMBER
Members of the USKBTC, as Stewards to the breed, have the obligation to protect and serve the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier at all times. A member's every action should reflect credit on themselves, the USKBTC and, above all, the Kerry Blue Terrier.
The approved standard for the breed is the fundamental imperative guiding our actions. Members have the obligation to protect and
serve these standards as a condition of membership.
Members must be familiar with and comply with the rules of the American Kennel Club (AKC); the Constitution and By-laws of the
USKBTC; and (as appropriate) the rules established by any member club of the USKBTC.
Members will observe the highest standards of conduct and sportsmanship at all times. Whether as a breeder, exhibitor, or spectator, they
shall conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the Kerry Blue Terrier, dogs in general, and the sport of showing dogs.
Members shall maintain the highest standards of health and sanitation for their own Kerry Blue Terriers, as well as for any other animals
in their possession or entrusted to their care. They shall demand the same high standards of others, members and non-members alike

II. RESPONSIBILITIES AS A BREEDER

ΑĿ	Breeder shall:
	Be guided at all times by the approved standard for the Kerry Blue Terrier and shall consider breeding only those specimens that conform to the standard.
	When contemplating breeding a litter or providing the services of a stud dog, strive toward maintaining breed type and producing dogs of exceptional quality, temperament, and condition. Breeding or supporting breeding to a lesser standard is not acceptable.
	Use for breeding only those dogs that are healthy and free from serious congenital and hereditary defects. Refrain from further use, any bitch or stud dog that has developed such a health problem or produced any serious inherited defects detrimental to the offspring and the overall well being of the breed.
	Not use a bitch for breeding prior to reaching eighteen (18) months of age (preferably 24 months) or older than eight (8) years of age. A bitch should not be bred more than two (2) out of three (3) consecutive heat cycles, nor produce more than five (5) litters in her lifetime. Recognizing the variations in heat cycles and sizes of litters, valid exceptions may exist, however it is incumbent on the breeder to exercise good judgment in exercising such
	exceptions. Not sell puppies to pet shops either outright or on consignment; supply puppies for auctions, raffles, or other such activities; refrain from selling to persons whose intention (either known or suspected) is to resell or use the puppy in a breeding program not complying with this code of ethics. The breeder shall ensure that the prospective buyer is prepared to provide the same degree of care required of members of the USKBTC. The Code of
	Ethics should be provided and discussed with potential buyers as part of a thorough screening process. All buyers should be encouraged to become members of the USKBTC and member clubs.
	Promptly apply for AKC registration of the litter. Puppies should not be sold prior to reaching ten (10) weeks of age (preferably 12 weeks). The sale of every dog shall include a signed registration or registration application (Blue Slip), and a four-generation pedigree. Any exceptions to these requirements, or valid restrictions or limitations imposed as conditions to the sale (e.g., no breeding) must be agreed to in writing by both parties at the time of sale. It is strongly recommended that a written agreement accompany all sales. Buyers should be provided with assistance and support in the setting of ears and in learning proper grooming. If the buyer is not located in the same area, the breeder should make arrangements with another
	USKBTC member in that area to assist the new owner. Provide with each sale, a record of dated and types of immunization given, immunizations required, and veterinary health records. Instructions should be provided, preferably in writing, on diseases and hereditary factors related to the breed, proper medical care, feeding, and grooming. Providing a copy of the current USKBTC Handbook represents a means of conveying this type of information, and is a sound investment on the part of the breeder. No puppy should be sold without either temporary or permanent protection against distemper-hepatitis and parvo. Puppies should have a veterinary examination, and worming if required, before sale.
	Maintain accurate and complete records of stock, matings, pedigrees, show records, and transfers. Breeders are responsible for conducting research on their pedigrees to ensure correct ancestry, accurate spelling of names, and correct registration numbers. Breeders should be familiar with and comply with all record keeping requirements required by the AKC. Litter registration applications must be correct and promptly requested. Individual puppy registration should be completed in a timely manner.
	Shall not engage in false or misleading advertising or other misrepresentations with respect to their own breeding. They shall not malign others by making false or misleading statements regarding another member's dogs, breeding practices, or person. Advertising should not be worded to attract undesirable buyers nor encourage raising dogs for profit.
	Consider the growing problems related to excess dogs ending up in animal shelters and should exercise sound judgment and prudent restraint in their breeding programs. Litters should be limited to numbers that are consistent with achieving a sound breeding program and the best interests of the Kerry Blue Terrier.
	Be prepared to assume lifetime responsibility for any litter produced.
	III. RESPONSIBILITIES AS AN EXHIBITOR OR HANDLER
	Act professionally at all times in caring for and exhibiting any dog in your charge. Do not engage in any questionable contact with judges prior to exhibiting under them. Comply with AKC Rules and Regulations for Dog Shows, Obedience Trials, Field Trials, and The Guidelines for Dog Show Judges. Exhibit or handle only those dogs that conform as closely as possible to the approved standard. Do not indulge in the practice of making "kennel majors", or exhibiting filler dogs that they know themselves to be unworthy of championships, for the purpose of finishing dogs. Such practices lessen the meaning and value of a championship and do not serve the breed.
	IV. ENFORCEMENT
	The USKBTC expects adherence to this Code of Ethics and blatant disregard of these standards will not be condoned. Violations of the standards are not in the best interests of the Club or the breed. Such behavior can serve as a cause of imposing discipline or terminating membership if charges are brought before the Board of Governors in accordance with the procedures as defined in Article VI (Discipline) of the USKBTC
	Constitution and Bylaws. Article VI addresses the specific procedures for proffering charges; the hearing process; and the rights of the parties involved. Each member is expected to be fully familiar with this very important provision of the By-laws. Revised: December 2010
